Responsibilities/Duties:

- 1. Ensure that all program activities comply with HOPE'87's quality standards and donor requirements.
- 2. Follow up on program progress, identify challenges, and devise solutions to ensure successful project implementation.
- 3. Conduct regular field visits to follow up and plan for project activities, provide technical guidance, and ensure objectives are being met.
- 4. Conduct Institutional Development Assessment (IDA) in the field, gather and analyze data, and collaborate with In Country Partners (ICPs) to develop work plans, tools and based on findings and follow ups to ensure the effectiveness of work plans.
- 5. Oversee the implementation and follow-up of the six capacities model, which includes management capacity, leadership capacity, gender-focused capacity, innovation capacity, adaptive capacity, and action capacity.
- 6. Ensure that relevant tools mentioned in work-plan developed subsequently after each training are developed organically by the ICPs themselves, and that ICPs staff are adequately supported through sharing of best practices.

- 7. Provide coaching support to field staff (if any) and ICPs to enhance their capabilities in program implementation and management and facilitate trainings and capacity building initiatives for field staff and ICPs
- 8. Prepare and submit regular program and field reports to the National Program Manager, detailing progress, challenges, and recommendations.
- 9. Maintain accurate records of all program activities, assessments, and follow-ups.
- 10. Work closely with the National Program Manager, field staff, and ICPs to ensure cohesive program implementation.
- 11. Maintain effective communication with all stakeholders to ensure transparency and alignment with project goals.

Qualifications:

Education: Bachelor or Master's degree in social sciences, development studies, project management, or a related field. A Master's degree is an asset.

Experience: Up to 3 years of relevant experience in program support, monitoring and evaluation, or a related role, preferably within an NGO or development sector working on a *Community-Led Development* model/approach.

Fresh graduates with a strong academic background in the relevant field or those possessing exceptional skills outlined in these Terms of Reference (TORs) are also encouraged to apply. They will be given a test and would be asked to complete a task or would be give a real-life situation to propose solution around etc.

Required Skills:
